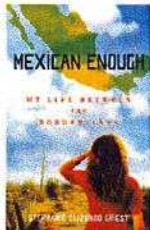

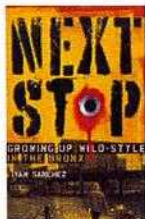


**Tuesday November 11**
